

SCHOLARSHIP AND FINANCIAL AID

MERIT BASED – DURING THE ADMISSION:

Based on the percentage in qualifying exam with following slabs

FOR UG PROGRAMME:

93% and above in 10 + 2	100%
Between 88 % to 92.99 % in 10 + 2	50%
Between 85% to 87.99% in 10 + 2	25%

FOR PG PROGRAMME:

93% and above and 80% in UG degree	100%
Between 88 % to 92.99 % & 75% in UG degree	50%
Between 85% to 87.99% & 70% in UG degree	25%

HARYANA DOMICILE BASED FEE CONCESSION:

25% of total haryana domiciled students are to be given fee concession on merit cum means basis as per the haryana private universities act.

OPEN FINANCIAL AID:

The university also has a limited number of open financial aid packages that are available to the students at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels, who are not eligible for either the merit-based scholarships or need-based financial aid.
