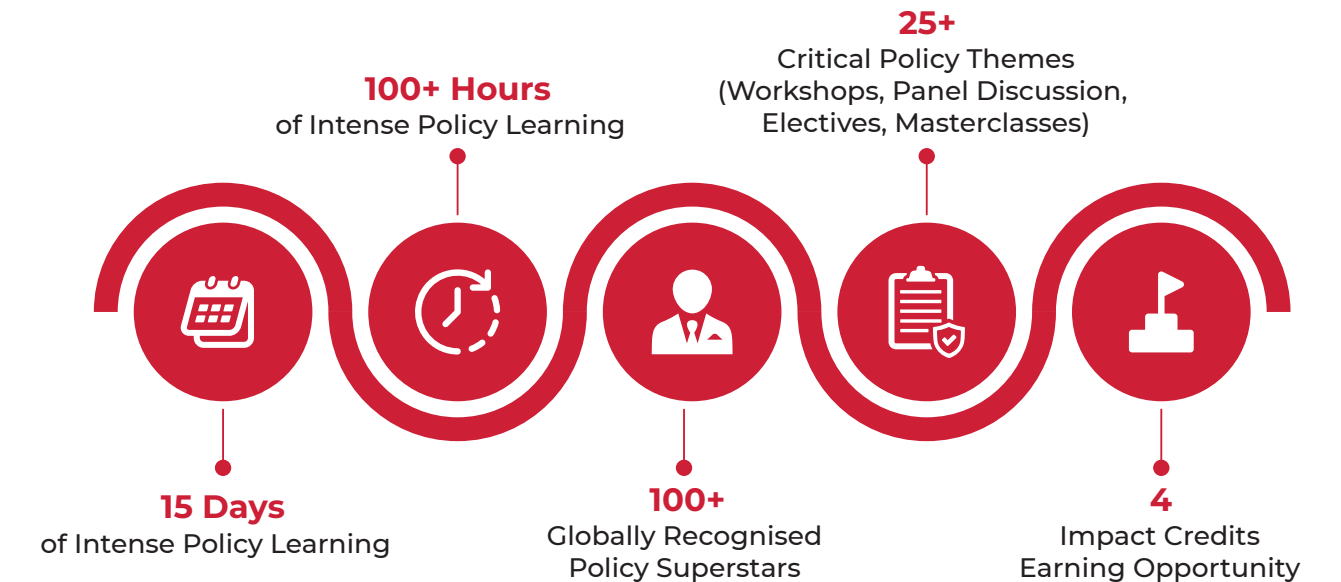

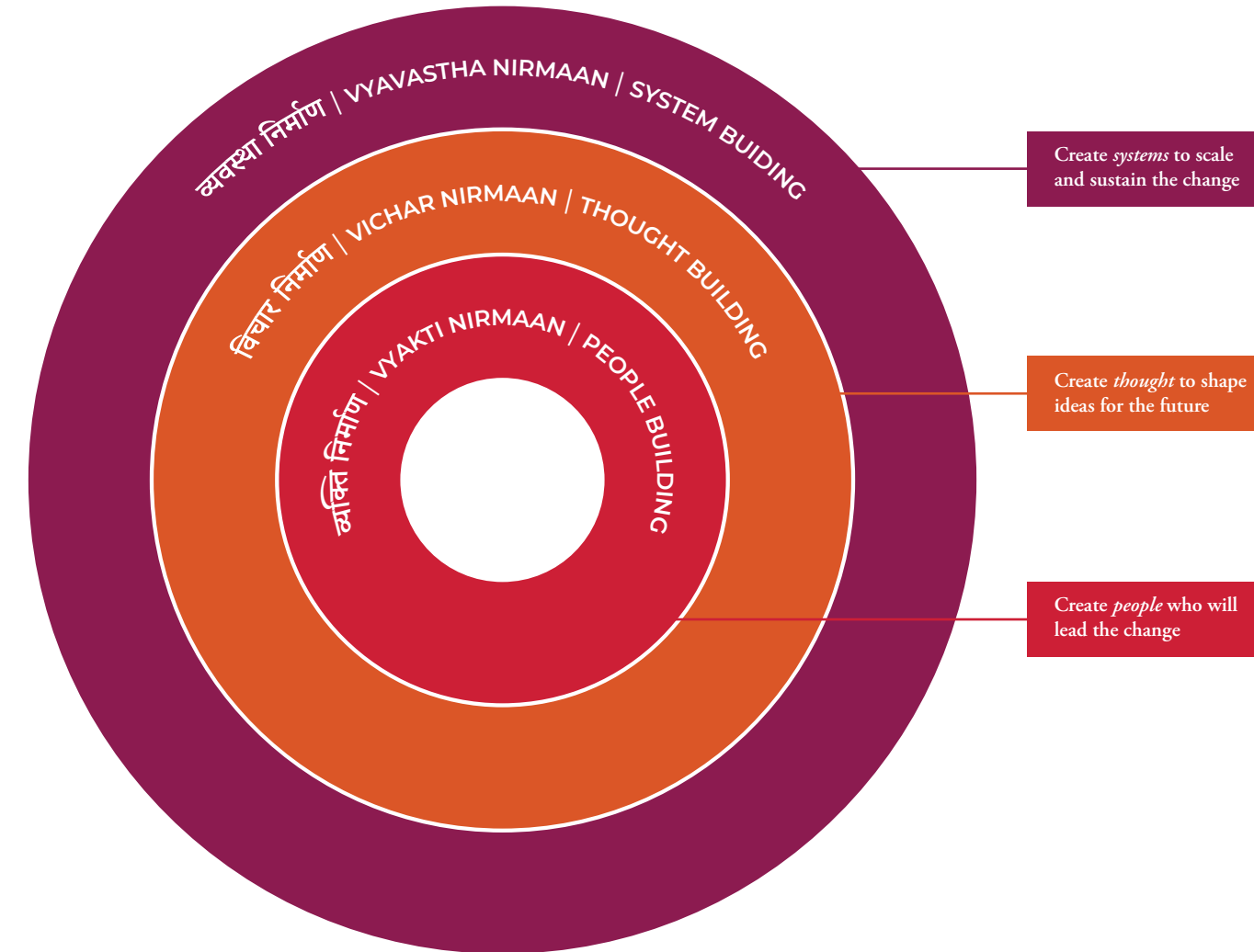

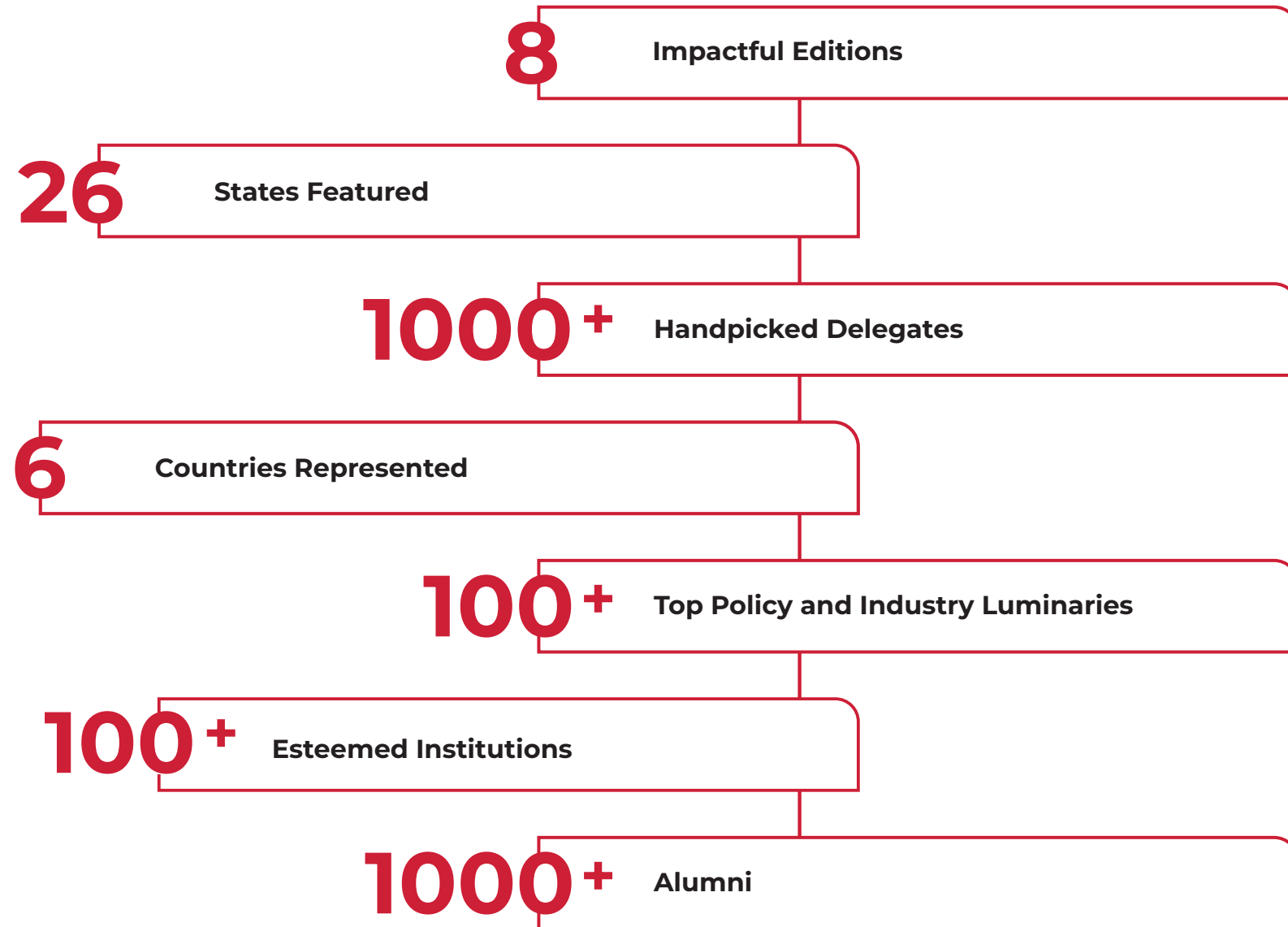

Siddhartha Bagri is the Founder & CEO of Pravaig Dynamics, a deep tech company building EVs, advanced batteries, and AI tools. He started Pravaig in 2011 in Jaipur with the goal to build world-leading products that take back control of time, resources, and sovereignty. He has 7 years of experience in the energy industry. He built projects and managed investments for a French Energy conglomerate in India, South Asia, and the Gulf region. Siddhartha Bagri also has 5 years of expertise in building manufacturing lines in India and China, from the ground up. He is a strong proponent of decentralized and open-source tools. He believes in privacy first, right to repair, and full upgradable technologies - three pillars that form the bedrock of all Pravaig tech.

The car's main competitors in the Indian market will be Audi e-tron, Ola Electric's maiden e-car (available by 2024), and Mercedes Benz EQC.

Deciding to start an electric car company was a no-brainer for childhood friends Siddhartha Bagri and Dhawal Khullar. They had been researching electric vehicles and joining forums online for hours after school since 2007-08. So when they had the opportunity to start their own company together, they knew exactly what they wanted to do.

This year, on 25 November, the duo's 11 years of hard work came to fruition with the launch of their deep tech company Pravaig Dynamics' e-SUV - the DEFY.

"In 2007-08, electric vehicle technology was just beginning to emerge. We were part of various global hobbyist groups dedicated to perfecting the technology. The electric vehicle forum had about 500-600 members from around the world and they included people from Rimac, Tesla, AC Propulsion, etc. We wanted to ensure there was good technology for electric vehicles. We were not happy with the existing products," explains Siddhartha Bagri.

On November 25th of this year, the hard work of a duo over the span of 11 years was brought to fruition in the form of an e-SUV from their deep tech company Pravaig Dynamics called the DEFY.

IAS officer Simi Karan hails from Odisha and did her schooling in Bhilai, Chhattisgarh. Her father used to work at Bhilai Steel Plant, while her mother was a teacher.

Being a studious student, IAS officer Simi Karan chose to pursue engineering after class 12. She enrolled at IIT Bombay to study electrical engineering, where she got the opportunity to interact with local slum children. This interaction changed her fate as she decided to prepare for the UPSC leaving her engineering career.

IAS officer Simi Karan observed top UPSC candidates' interviews as she prepared for the exam. Simi Karan achieved an All India Rank of 31 in the UPSC in 2019 and was appointed an IAS officer.

Defining her success mantra in cracking UPSC, IAS officer Simi Karan said that she always focused on the quality of studies. "I never focused on the hours of study but rather set short-term goals (daily, sometimes even hourly) to focus on completion... Hence, the schedule fluctuated accordingly but on average, I studied for 8-10 hours. I also want to highlight that I focused on the quality of studies, limited resources, and took out time for recreation like jogging, watching stand-up comedy to relax my mind." IAS officer Simi Karan said.
